trash pickup shift

some residents to receive new trash, recycling days

The garbage and recycling day will change for nearly a quarter of the Town's solid waste customers beginning the week of April 14.

Waste Industries, our solid waste collector, is redrawing route maps to better balance workloads in light of growth patterns.

In recent years, daily collection areas have become increasingly fragmented.

In redrawing maps, Waste Industries has focused on creating geographical bands for each day that can be shifted as needed without requiring wholesale schedule changes every few years.

The upcoming changes in garbage and recycling affect 23 percent of Holly Springs customers. Yard waste collection does not change.

Visit www.hollyspringsnc.us and see Garbage & Recycling under the Services tab. You'll find a map of the new routes plus the daily collection schedule by subdivision and selected streets.

Waste Industries intends to send postcards to those whose collection day is changing about two weeks ahead of time.

See the back page for the new trash and recycling schedule. The collection day is changing for 23 percent of customers.

With the way collection routes are being drawn, Waste Industries said, drivers are likely to be near the neighborhoods that they worked the previous day.

If a driver misses a home for any reason, returning there to collect should be easier than before.

Waste Industries has tried to avoid splitting subdivisions.
