



## Holly Springs Parks & Recreation Picnic Shelter Policies

The Shelter will be cleaned prior to your arrival time. Renters will be responsible for leaving the rental area as it was found. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of part or whole of the deposit.

Deposits are processed by the first business day of the month following your rental provided the facilities are left in "as-rented" conditions with trash and recycling placed in appropriate containers and tables and chairs left clean and intact.

No cash can be exchanged during the rental period or on Town property.

Ample time should be allowed for set up and clean up within your rental time. You must be prepared to leave by the end of your rental time. Rentals ending at dark must complete cleanup before closing at dark.

All trash and personal items must be properly disposed of or removed from the facility.

Smoking is prohibited.

Personal grills are not allowed in the picnic shelter or parking lot. Stationary grills are provided for use.

Pig cookers may be permitted with approval from the respective Facility Manager. Cookers must be attended at all times and have a drip pan underneath to prevent damage to the Park's grounds if the cooker is permitted.

The Bass Lake Park Shelter and Veterans Park Shelter have a maximum occupancy of forty (40) people, the Womble Park Bandshell has a maximum occupancy of forty-five (45) people, and the Womble Park Shelter is limited to one hundred (100) occupants. Additional tables and seating may be allowed with the respective Facility Manager's approval provided they are not used to increase capacity and are not placed on walkways or in the parking lot and do not hinder Park operations.

Picnic tables are stationary and do not move.

Painters tape may be used to hang or place decorations. Any other tape nails, putty, glue, pins, hooks, thumbtacks, command strips or staples are prohibited.

Sustained or repeating loud noises of any kind are prohibited at all times. Amplified music or DJs are not allowed.

Canopies, tents, and inflatable bounce houses are not allowed.
